SUBJECT: MISSION REPORT

19 DECEMBER 1944

6TH NIGHT FIGHTER SQUADRON AAF MISSION 12-3

1. a. One (1) P-61B
b. One (1) B-25
2. a. None.

3. Scrambled at 2330
4. LT. KERN, PILOT; LT. SOBOL, OBSERVER. (SCARLET FIVE)

Takeoff: 2340 - Landed: 2350

Scrambled on course to HICKAM FIELD at 3,000 ft on orders from control. Saw searchlights all over the area, and notified control of this fact. Control reported target was in the searchlights. LT. KERN then sighted target when he was about 10 miles distant, flying over HICKAM FIELD at 2,200 ft., heading North, at 2344. Target then made 180 degree turn and flew back over PEARL HARBOR. LT. KERN closed in to within 50 ft on control's orders and identified target as a B-25. Our aircraft was then ordered to land at base.
